Join us on a **5K walk**, and Health and wellness Fair. All while you honor the memory of a loved one and help raise funds for Kara's grief support programs.


Food and activities for kids and adults will be available after the walk. Come to enjoy fun and sharing!

- Lost and Found and First Aid are both located at the finish area




